The **Bright Changes Clubhouse** is a community-based youth-guided and family-centered free program, addressing the social and emotional needs of youth ages 9 – 21. All youth and emerging adults in the program are referred to as Club Members. Club Members will receive case management, age-appropriate life skills, training and academic support.
