

Substance Use Disorders Information

The Bad News:

- 1 in 4 Americans who began using any addictive substance before age 18 developed an addiction.
- 75 percent of all high school students have used addictive substances, including tobacco, alcohol, marijuana or cocaine.
- Addicted teens lose friends, isolate themselves, and fail in school.

The Good News:

- Most teens dealing with a drug or alcohol addiction **benefit** from leaving their home and entering a safe, and therapeutic environment with others of their same age and gender.
- The Hartmann Center provides treatment that enhances youth's ability to engage in age appropriate community activity, develop health relationships and retain school tenure.
- The Hartmann Center supports for the entire family through recovery education, family sessions and inclusive transition planning prior to completion of the program.

The George W. Hartmann Center is a co-ed long-term trauma informed, residential substance use disorder recovery program for teens, ages 13-17. Hartmann provides 24 hour supervised, planned living, and recovery services in a therapeutic environment. The program offers comprehensive assessments and individualized treatment planning. The center accepts teens from all counties in Georgia.

The Hartmann Center contracts with Marietta City Schools for educational services for high school students. Classroom instruction is provided onsite by highly qualified educators employed by Marietta City Schools. Credit hours earned while in treatment can be transferred back to the students' local school system. Children in middle school attend classes at the local Ombudsman Center.
