Staff works with each person to improve life skills (ADL's) and to enhance the quality of life through exercise, education, volunteerism, arts and crafts, and recreational/leisure activities.

These activities take place in our 10,000 sq. ft. newly renovated facility*. It contains 13 classrooms suited for intimate group settings. CBTC also has a fleet of vehicles for all service needs including Utility Lift vans, 15x passenger vehicles and mini vans for community outings.

* Seven rest rooms, a shower room, Laundry room, Nursing station with 3 beds, kitchenette/cafeteria, arts & crafts room with a kiln and mosaic glass tools, and outdoor gardening space.



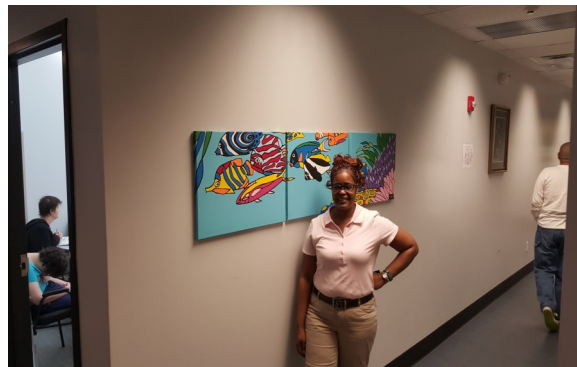
Our Staff



Choices 2 Direct Support Professionals are trained in over 60 areas of direct care including:

- *Positive Behavioral Support,*
- *Crisis Prevention Intervention,*
- *Basic Life Support (CPR)*
- *NADSP Direct Support Professional Certification Course Levels 1-3.*

Current Staff is comprised of Registered Nurses, Certified Nursing Assistants, Medical Technicians and Social Service focused degree holders both at the Bachelors and Master levels.



World Without Walls (WOW)



This program, based in the community*, assists with individuals in improving their daily living skills (ADL's) by enhanced interactions with their peers and community members.

Educational programs offered each day;

- Volunteerism,
- Arts and crafts,
- Travel training (CCT, MARTA, Street Car)
- Special outings, at a minimum of once a week, that include fun events such as bowling, a trip to the movies, rock climbing, or some shopping.

Monday through Friday, individuals try their hands at job skill development, learning money skills and basic awareness of what is expected in the workplace.

*Transportation is provided to and from all activities.
