The George W. Hartmann Center is a co-ed, long-term trauma, residential substance use disorder recovery program for teens, ages 13-17. Hartmann provides 24 hour supervised, planned living, and recovery services in a therapeutic environment. We offer comprehensive assessments and individualized treatment planning. The center accepts teens from all counties in Georgia.
