

New Start Men's Program

The Cobb County Community Services Board's New Start's Men's program is an intensive outpatient alcohol and drug treatment and transitional housing program for adult men ages 18 and over. Participants of the program must have a primary diagnosis of substance abuse or dependency. The average length of stay for the program is 30 days. The CSB offers necessary substance abuse education, relapse prevention, and supportive services for this population. These services will significantly reduce the rate of recidivism for these clients by providing education on the process of addiction, helping clients identify triggers, and helping them develop a support network by promoting wellness and recovery.

The major components of this gender-specific program will be: 1) daily substance abuse education group; 2) weekly individual therapy; 3) weekly multi-family education; 4) supportive employment referral; 5) ongoing assessment of services and need; 6) person center treatment planning; 7) AA/NA meetings; 8) random urine drug screens; and 9) continuing care/discharge planning.

Admission Criteria:

Adult males, 18 years of age or over

Primary diagnoses of substance abuse and/or dependency

Discharged from a Crisis Stabilization Program within two weeks or clients with pending discharge dates
