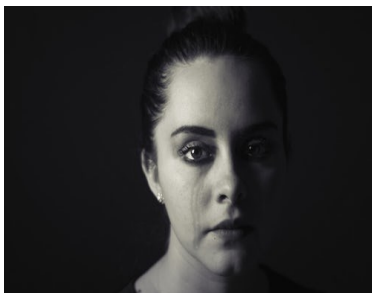


Recovery Services

Overview of Cobb Outpatient Clinic

The Cobb Outpatient Clinic provides a wide range of treatment services for individuals with behavioral health challenges. Additionally, we offer education and supports to manage illness and develop skills necessary to function in the community. Family education and support are also an important component of our treatment.

We treat the uninsured and the underinsured and offer walk-in accessibility for assessments Mon.-Fri. from 7 a.m.-3 p.m.



Our Services

Our **mental illness and wellness services** include:

- Psychiatric assessment and evaluation
- Peer support
- Psychosocial rehabilitation
- Case management
- Group, individual, and family counseling
- Pharmacy services
- Medication management
- Resource coordination
- Day treatment programs
- Intensive residential services

Our **addictive disease** programs include the following:

- Behavioral health assessment
- Group, individual, and family counseling

Criminal justice services are provided for incarcerated and court involved adults with a mental illness or substance-related disorder.

These include: Assessment and evaluation, court interfacing, individual counseling, linkage and referral, and medication monitoring. In a joint partnership through WellStar Health Systems, Cobb County Community Services Board offers behavioral health services in the Cobb County Adult Detention Center.
